

DCH Lifeguards:

Under the direction of the Aquatics Director, Lifeguards are responsible for the safety of pool patrons and the day-to-day operation of the summer aquatics program which includes swim lessons and open swim for summer day camp; preschool, youth and family swim lessons; and membership/community open swim. Lifeguards are also responsible for helping to maintain a clean and safe aquatic environment through safety checks, equipment maintenance, and appropriate water testing, among other procedures insuring the pool is always kept to the standards required per Massachusetts regulations.

Qualified candidates will be 16 years of age or older, have current ARC or YMCA certifications in Lifeguarding, CPR for the Professional Rescuer, AED, O2 and First Aid. Water Safety Instruction (W.S.I.) is not required but is preferred. The DCH pool season is around 14 weeks from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. It is preferred that candidates be available for as much of the summer as possible.
